### September 2024

The receiving terminal was officially ready to receive CO<sub>2</sub>.

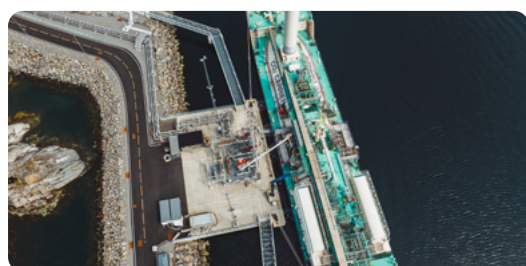


### February 2025

The first CO<sub>2</sub> ship, Northern Pioneer arrived in our hometown Stavanger, where we held a Godmother ceremony.

### March 2025

Stockholm Exergi made the Final Investment Decision. From 2026, CO<sub>2</sub> from Sweden will be stored beneath the Norwegian seabed.



### June 2025

We completed the successful offloading of the first CO<sub>2</sub> cargo from Heidelberg Materials in Øygarden.



### June 2025

The Longship project was officially completed along with the arrival and Godmother ceremony of Northern Pathfinder.

### August 2025

The first injection! 2,600 metres under the seabed, Northern Lights begins permanent CO<sub>2</sub> storage. A turning point for European climate action.
