CO₂ is captured at
Heidelberg Materials in Brevik.

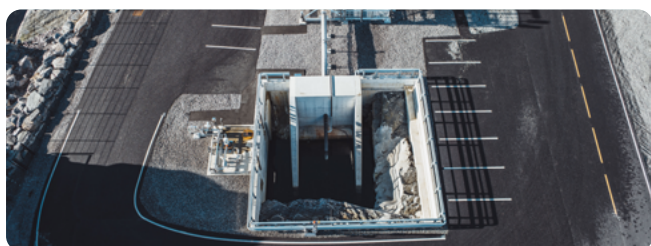


Captured CO₂ is liquefied, cooled, and loaded onto
purpose-built CO₂ carriers.

Specialised CO₂ ships transport the CO₂ safely
across borders to Øygarden.



At Øygarden, CO₂ is offloaded
and stored temporarily in onshore
tanks before injection.



CO₂ is transported through a 100-kilometre pipeline
and injected 2,600 metres below the seabed into the
Aurora reservoir – for safe and permanent storage.
